

Apparatus Accident Procedures

- For apparatus accidents, do **not** provide your private insurance information.
- You **must** give your name and address exactly as it appears on your driver's license.
- Death, Injury or a Major Accident can result in a Police Officer or the Fire Department demanding blood and/or urine tests.
Notify the UFA immediately.
Members are **not** required to make any statements to the police.
Members are **not** required to make any statements to FDNY Chief Officers without representation.
- Make sure that code **(994)** is inserted **boldly in black ink** on the MV-104 or your private insurance will be used!
- If no officer is present, you are required to fill out the CD-19.
- If a line-of-duty accident impacts your private insurance status, please contact Safety Command Accident Claims Unit at 718-999-2936.
