*There are **licensed, experienced CSU Counselors** available to help*

*If you need **more specialized care, including prescriptions for WTC-covered mental health meds, your CSU Counselor can refer you to an FDNY WTC Psychiatrist or FDNY WTC Mental Health Nurse Practitioner***

*Your CSU care is **expert, confidential, and free***

Have WTC mental health certification & receiving WTC Counseling from non-FD Psychiatrist, Therapist, or Mental Health Nurse Practitioner?

*If your Counselor is not already an FDNY WTC Provider, please **ask them to call Teja (pronounced Tay-Hah) Pekija at CSU – 212-570-1693, ext 318** – for process required to become an authorized WTC provider*

CSU has network of participating non-FD WTC counseling and mental health providers in the Metro NY area & around the U.S.

*Approved sessions are **free***

If your CSU-approved non-FD WTC Counselor is also a prescriber –

Prescriptions for WTC-covered mental health meds are covered –zero co-pay

Please present your WTC Prescription card to your pharmacist - FD WTC Prescription staff will override the initial rejection for ongoing fills.
