The form is for notification purposes only and does NOT constitute an application for retirement or reclassification pursuant to Chapter 93 of the Laws of 2005. - 3) The New York City Morgue or temporary morgue on pier locations on the west side of Manhattan; or
- 4) The barges between the west side of Manhattan and the Fresh Kills Landfill.
